What to do...

If you are concerned about an adult at risk of abuse or neglect

PRACTITIONER HAS CONCERNS THE WELFARE OF AN ADULT AT RISK OF ABUSE OR NEGLECT



DO NOT IGNORE YOUR CONCERN

Gather available information about your concern DO NOT ALERT ANY POTENTIAL ABUSER

DISCUSS WITH YOUR COLLEAGUES/MANAGER & SAFEGUARDING LEAD



THE MAIN PRIORITY FOR EVERY PRACTITIONER
IS THAT
THE ADULT AT RISK IS SAFE



CONCERN REMAINS

This may be even when others do not feel that your worries are safeguarding DO NOT IGNORE YOUR



CONCERNS RESOLVED

Consider possible referral to other agencies for continued support
